



To Whom at May Concern:

Tahoe Southeast has been a RF label source tagger for the past 2 years. Over the last year we applied approximately 43,000,000 RF labels onto cardboard stock that is used in the packaging of items sold in retail stores.

On April 7, 2006 we conducted a RF label source- tagging test between Checkpoint Systems and All-Tag Security on their 410 / 4 Series style RF labels. We used 24,000 RF labels from both companies for the test. The Checkpoint labels came in rolls of 4,000 and the All-Tag came in rolls of 8,000. The RF labels were applied with a Label-Aire 3100 at a rate of 550 per minute. The following are the results of the test.




<u>Company</u>	<u>Total RF Labels on the Rolls</u>	<u>Number of Live RF labels after application</u>	<u>Percentage Deactivated during Application*</u>
All-Tag	24,492	23,938	0.26%
Checkpoint	24,154	23,804	0.82%

* Percentage based on the 24,000 RF labels the manufacturers showed as live on the rolls.

In our opinion both the All-Tag and Checkpoint RF labels performed the same in ease of application and we found no notable differences. We have attached a copy of the manufacturer information from each roll of RF labels for your reference.
